A person who wants to have the person's name printed on the ballot as a candidate for director 8 must file with the board secretary a petition requesting that 9 action. The petition must be: 10 signed by at least 10 registered voters; and 11 (1)12 (2) filed by the deadline imposed by Section 144.005, Election Code [at least 25 days before the date of the election]. 13

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
