- SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Julia Wells Act. 6
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is 7
- 8 amended by adding Section 1001.1021 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1001.1021. HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION INFORMATION. 9
- (a) The commission by rule shall require that information relating 10
- to human trafficking prevention be included in the curriculum of 11
- any driver education course or driving safety course. 12
- (b) In developing rules under this section, the commission 13
- 14 shall consult with the human trafficking prevention coordinating
- council established under Section 402.034, Government Code. 15
- 16 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than May 1, 2022, the Texas
- Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules 17
- required by Section 1001.1021, Education Code, as added by this 18
- Act. 19
- (b) Each driver education course or driving safety course 20
- held on or after September 1, 2022, must include in the course 21
- curriculum the information required by Section 22 1001.1021,
- 23 Education Code, as added by this Act.
