This <u>subsection expires September 1, 2022.</u> 10 (h-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (h), in determining 11 12 whether a student described by Subsection (a-1) is qualified to graduate, an individual graduation committee is not required to 13 14 consider criteria under Subsection (h) relating to the student's performance on an end-of-course assessment instrument administered 15 under Section 39.023. This subsection expires September 1, 2022. 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
