4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 28.0258, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsections (a-1) and (h-1) to read as follows:

7 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), this section applies

8 to any student in grade 12 during the 2020-2021, 2021-2022, or

9 2022-2023 school year regardless of whether the student meets the

10 criteria described by Subsection (a). This subsection expires

11 September 1, 2023.

12 (h-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (h), in determining

whether a student described by Subsection (a-1) is qualified to

graduate, an individual graduation committee is not required to

15 consider criteria under Subsection (h) relating to the student's

16 performance on an end-of-course assessment instrument administered

17 under Section 39.023. This subsection expires September 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
