A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to adjustment of the average daily attendance for school 3 districts providing additional half-day instruction for certain 4 students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 48.0051, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-2) to read as 8 follows:

9 (a) Subject to Subsection (a-1), the commissioner shall 10 adjust the average daily attendance of a school district or 11 open-enrollment charter school under Section 48.005 in the manner 12 provided by Subsection (b) if the district or school:

(1) provides the minimum number of minutes of operational and instructional time required under Section 25.081 and commissioner rules adopted under that section over at least 180 days of instruction <u>as provided by Subsection (a-2)</u>; and

17 (2) offers an additional 30 days of half-day
18 instruction for students enrolled in prekindergarten through fifth
19 grade.

20 <u>(a-2) To be eligible for the adjustment to the average daily</u> 21 <u>attendance under Subsection (a), a school district or</u> 22 <u>open-enrollment charter school is only required to provide the</u> 23 <u>minimum number of minutes of operational and instructional time</u> 24 <u>described by Subsection (a)(1) over at least 180 days of</u>

1 instruction for students to whom the district or school offers the 2 additional 30 days of half-day instruction.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
