A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the inclusion of suicide prevention information on
3	certain student identification cards issued by a public or private
4	school or postsecondary educational institution.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 38.353 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 38.353. SUICIDE PREVENTION INFORMATION REQUIRED ON
9	CERTAIN STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS. Each student identification
10	card issued by a public or private school to a student in grade six
11	or higher:
12	(1) must have printed on the card the contact
13	<pre>information for:</pre>
14	(A) the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline;
15	<u>and</u>
16	(B) the Crisis Text Line; and
17	(2) may have printed on the card the contact
18	information for a local suicide prevention hotline, if available.
19	SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
20	amended by adding Section 51.91941 to read as follows:
21	Sec. 51.91941. SUICIDE PREVENTION INFORMATION REQUIRED ON
22	STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD. (a) In this section, "postsecondary
23	educational institution" means:
24	(1) an institution of higher education or a private or

- 2 defined by Section 61.003; or
- 3 (2) a career school or college as defined by Section
- 4 132.001.
- 5 (b) Each student identification card issued by a
- 6 postsecondary educational institution:
- 7 (1) must have printed on the card the contact
- 8 information for:
- 9 (A) the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline;
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (B) the Crisis Text Line; and
- 12 (2) may have printed on the card the contact
- 13 information for:
- 14 (A) the campus police department or security for
- 15 the campus at which the student to whom the card is issued regularly
- 16 attends classes or, if the campus does not have a campus police
- 17 department or security, a local nonemergency police contact;
- 18 (B) the campus health clinic for the campus at
- 19 which the student to whom the card is issued regularly attends
- 20 classes or, if the campus does not have a health clinic, a local
- 21 <u>health clinic; and</u>
- (C) a local suicide prevention hotline, if
- 23 <u>available.</u>
- SECTION 3. Sections 38.353 and 51.91941, Education Code, as
- 25 added by this Act, apply only to a student identification card
- 26 issued on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
