A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to disposition of motor vehicle registration fees
- 3 collected by a county assessor-collector.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 502.198(b) and (c), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Each Tuesday, a county assessor-collector shall credit
- 8 to the county road and bridge fund an amount equal to the net
- 9 collections made during the preceding week until the amount so
- 10 credited for the calendar year equals the total of:
- 11 (1) \$200,000 [\$60,000]; and
- 12 (2) $\frac{$600}{}$ [\$\frac{\$350}{}] for each mile of county road
- 13 maintained by the county, according to the most recent information
- 14 available from the department, not to exceed 500 miles.
- 15 (c) After the credits to the county road and bridge fund
- 16 equal the total computed under Subsection (b), each Tuesday the
- 17 county assessor-collector shall:
- 18 (1) credit to the county road and bridge fund an amount
- 19 equal to 50 percent of the net collections made during the preceding
- 20 week, until the amount so credited for the calendar year equals
- 21 \$500,000 [\$125,000]; and
- 22 (2) send to the department an amount equal to 50
- 23 percent of those collections for deposit to the credit of the state
- 24 highway fund.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
