## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the terms and qualifications of the members of the port
- 3 commission of, and the powers, duties, and territory of, the Port of
- 4 Harlingen Authority; authorizing the imposition of a tax.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 5013, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 7 is amended by designating Sections 5013.001 and 5013.002 as
- 8 Subchapter A and adding a subchapter heading to read as follows:
- 9 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 5013.001, Special District Local Laws
- 11 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 5013.001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [<u>DEFINITION</u>]. In this chapter:
- 13 (1) "Authority" [, "authority"] means the Port of
- 14 Harlingen Authority.
- 15 (2) "Port commission" means the governing body of the
- 16 authority.

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- 17 (3) "Port commissioner" means a member of the port
- 18 commission.
- 19 (4) "Treasurer" means the treasurer of the authority.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 5013, Special District
- 21 Local Laws Code, as added by this Act, is amended by adding Section
- 22 5013.0025 to read as follows:
- 23 Sec. 5013.0025. AUTHORITY TERRITORY. The authority is
- 24 composed of the original territory of the district, as it may have

- 1 been amended by Subchapter H, Chapter 62, Water Code, or other law,
- 2 except the territory does not include any portion of Willacy
- 3 County.
- 4 SECTION 4. Chapter 5013, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 5 is amended by adding Subchapter B, and a heading is added to that
- 6 subchapter to read as follows:
- 7 <u>SUBCHAPTER B. PORT COMMISSION</u>
- 8 SECTION 5. Section 5013.003, Special District Local Laws
- 9 Code, is transferred to Subchapter B, Chapter 5013, Special
- 10 District Local Laws Code, as added by this Act, redesignated as
- 11 Section 5013.051, and amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 5013.051 [ $\frac{5013.003}{}$ ]. GOVERNING BODY. (a) The
- 13 navigation and canal commission of the authority is called the port
- 14 commission and is composed of five port commissioners.
- 15 (b) The port commissioners shall be elected by the voters of
- 16 the district at large to positions numbered one through five.
- (c) Port commissioners serve staggered four-year terms,
- 18 with port commissioners elected in odd-numbered years.
- 19 SECTION 6. Chapter 5013, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 20 is amended by adding Subchapters C and D to read as follows:
- SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES
- Sec. 5013.101. TREASURER. (a) The port commission:
- 23 (1) shall hire or appoint a treasurer; and
- 24 (2) may terminate or suspend the employment or
- 25 appointment of the treasurer.
- (b) The treasurer has the power and duties of a treasurer
- 27 under Chapters 60 and 62, Water Code.

- 1 (c) Notwithstanding Section 62.152, Water Code, the
- 2 treasurer shall pay all authority expenses from authority funds.
- 3 Sec. 5013.102. SALES AND LEASES. (a) Except as provided by
- 4 this section, the provisions of Subchapter C, Chapter 60, Water
- 5 Code, apply to all sales and leases entered into by the authority.
- 6 (b) Notwithstanding Section 60.039, Water Code, the
- 7 authority may enter into a surface lease for a period of not more
- 8 than 99 years.
- 9 (c) Notwithstanding Section 60.040, Water Code, the
- 10 authority is not required to publish notice for a sale, easement, or
- 11 lease for a period of not more than 99 years.
- 12 (d) Sections 60.041 and 60.042, Water Code, do not apply to
- 13 a bid on real property to be sold by the authority.
- 14 SUBCHAPTER D. FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
- 15 Sec. 5013.151. MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION TAX; TAX RATE.
- 16 (a) The authority may impose an ad valorem tax at a rate not to
- 17 exceed 10 cents on each \$100 valuation of all taxable property in
- 18 the authority for the maintenance, operation, and upkeep of the
- 19 authority and the improvements constructed by the authority.
- 20 (b) The authority may change the rate or suspend collection
- 21 of the tax authorized by this section in the manner provided by law
- 22 for official action by the authority, subject to the limitation
- 23 prescribed by Subsection (a).
- (c) Section 62.160, Water Code, does not apply to the
- 25 authority.
- Sec. 5013.152. SELECTION OF DEPOSITORY. (a) Except as
- 27 provided by this section, the authority shall select a depository

- 1 for the authority in the manner provided by Section 60.271, Water
- 2 Code.
- 3 (b) The authority shall select a depository in a manner to
- 4 ensure that authority funds are fully insured by the Federal
- 5 Deposit Insurance Corporation or the National Credit Union Share
- 6 Insurance Fund.
- 7 (c) The authority may select more than one institution to
- 8 serve as a depository in order to comply with the requirement under
- 9 Subsection (b).
- 10 SECTION 7. (a) In this section, "authority," "port
- 11 commission," and "port commissioner" have the meanings assigned by
- 12 Section 5013.001, Special District Local Laws Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act.
- 14 (b) A port commissioner of the authority who is serving on
- 15 the day before the effective date of this Act shall serve until a
- 16 successor qualifies following an election under Subsection (c) of
- 17 this section.
- 18 (c) On the uniform election date in November 2021, the port
- 19 commission shall hold an election to elect two port commissioners,
- 20 numbered four and five.
- 21 (d) The three port commissioners serving on the effective
- 22 date of this Act shall draw lots to assign port commissioner numbers
- 23 one through three and determine which two port commissioners shall
- 24 serve a term expiring December 1, 2023, and which port commissioner
- 25 shall serve a term expiring December 1, 2025.
- 26 (e) On the uniform election date in November 2023, the port
- 27 commission shall hold an election to elect two port commissioners

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- 1 to terms of four years.
- 2 (f) On the uniform election date in 2025, the port
- 3 commission shall hold an election to elect three port commissioners
- 4 to terms of four years.
- 5 SECTION 8. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 6 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 7 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 8 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 9 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 10 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 11 Government Code.
- 12 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 13 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 14 Environmental Quality.
- 15 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 16 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 17 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 18 representatives within the required time.
- 19 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 20 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 21 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 22 and accomplished.
- 23 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
