1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the use of personal leave during school holidays by
 1-24 certain school district employees.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 22.003, Education Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

1-28 (g) A school district employee with available personal
 1-29 leave under this section is entitled to use the leave for
 1-30 compensation for a day designated as a school holiday for which the
 1-31 employee would otherwise not receive compensation. An employee may
 1-32 not use more than the number of personal leave days provided to the
 1-33 employee per year under this section or by the school district for
 1-34 days designated as school holidays during that year. This
 1-35 subsection applies only to a school district employee who is not:

1-36 (1) exempt from the overtime provisions of the federal
 1-37 Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. Section 201 et seq.);
 1-38 and

1-39 (2) employed on a salaried basis.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
