Section 300101 et 18 19 seq.). 20 (d) The Texas Department of Transportation is not required to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless a 21 grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the 22 23 cost of the design, construction, and erection of the marker. Money received to cover the cost of the marker shall be deposited to the 24
