4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2002, Insurance Code, is

6 amended by adding Section 2002.007 to read as follows:

under a residential property insurance policy.

7 Sec. 2002.007. REPLACEMENT COST COVERAGE REQUIREMENTS. (a)

8 This section applies to each insurer authorized to engage in the

9 business of residential property insurance in this state, including

10 <u>a county mutual insurance company, farm mutual insurance company,</u>

11 Lloyd's plan, and reciprocal or interinsurance exchange.

12 (b) A residential property insurance policy that includes

13 replacement cost coverage must provide that in a valid claim for

14 damage to insured property, the insurer must pay the full

15 replacement cost of the property without regard to whether the

16 insured has completed repair or replacement of the property.

17 SECTION 2. Section 2002.007, Insurance Code, as added by

18 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for

19 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2022.

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
