## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the mandatory transfer of certain protective orders
- 3 that affect a party's right to possession of or access to a child.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 85, Family Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 85.0641 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 85.0641. MANDATORY TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROTECTIVE
- 8 ORDERS. (a) This section applies only in a county with a population
- 9 of four million or more.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding Section 85.064(a), during the pendency
- 11 of a suit affecting the parent-child relationship, a court that
- 12 renders a protective order that affects the right of a party to the
- 13 <u>suit to possession of or access to a child shall transfer the</u>
- 14 protection order to the court having jurisdiction of the suit
- 15 affecting the parent-child relationship.
- SECTION 2. Section 85.0641, Family Code, as added by this
- 17 Act, applies only to a protective order rendered on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act. A protective order rendered before that
- 19 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the order was
- 20 rendered, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
