A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the information maintained by the Texas Education
3	Agency regarding postsecondary education and career opportunities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 7.040, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) The agency shall prepare information comparing
9	institutions of higher education in this state and post the
10	information on the agency's Internet website. Information prepared
11	under this section shall be given to a public school student who
12	requests the information. The information shall:
13	(1) identify postsecondary education and career
14	opportunities, including information that states the benefits of
15	four-year and two-year higher education programs, postsecondary
16	technical education, skilled workforce careers, and career
17	education programs;
18	(2) compare each institution of higher education with
19	other institutions, both overall and disaggregated by
20	baccalaureate or associate degree or certificate program,
21	regarding:

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(A) the relative cost of tuition;

(B) the retention rate of students;

(C) the graduation rate of students;

1	(D) the <u>median</u> [average] student debt <u>, based on</u>
2	the most recent data released through the United States Department
3	of Education's College Scorecard online tool or a successor tool;
4	(E) the loan repayment rate of students; [and]
5	(F) the employment rate of students; and
6	(G) the median earnings of students, expressed as
7	a yearly amount and as a percentage of student debt, at the first,
8	fifth, and tenth year after graduation, based on the most recent
9	data released through the United States Department of Education's
10	College Scorecard online tool or a successor tool;
11	(3) identify the state's future workforce needs, as
12	projected by the Texas Workforce Commission; and
13	(4) include annual wage information for the top 10
14	highest demand jobs in this state, as identified by the Texas
15	Workforce Commission.
16	(a-1) The information required under Subsections (a)(2)(D)
17	and (G) must be updated each time new data described by those
18	paragraphs is released through the United States Department of
19	Education's College Scorecard online tool or a successor tool.
20	SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
21	date of this Act, the Texas Education Agency shall update the
22	information required under Section 7.040(a), Education Code, as
23	amended by this Act.
24	(b) As soon as practicable after the Texas Education Agency

completes the update required by Subsection (a) of this section,

the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall update the

comparative gainful employment data regarding public institutions

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- 1 of higher education required to be maintained by the board under
- 2 Sections 51.762(b-1) and 51.763(b), Education Code, to include the
- 3 information required under Section 7.040(a), Education Code, as
- 4 amended by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
