If the governor issues an executive order, proclamation, or regulation 8 9 during a declared state of disaster that restricts the operation of a business or category of businesses, a business whose operation is 10 restricted by the order, proclamation, or regulation may not be 11 12 assessed any tax or fee, including a licensing fee, by this state during the time the operation of the business is restricted by the 13 14 order, proclamation, or regulation. 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
