- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.830, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 61.830. PUBLICATION OF GUIDELINES ADDRESSING TRANSFER
- 9 PRACTICES. (a) In the institution's [its] course catalogs and on
- 10 the institution's Internet [its] website, each institution of
- 11 higher education shall publish guidelines addressing the practices
- 12 of the institution regarding the transfer of course credit. In the
- 13 guidelines, the institution must identify a course by using the
- 14 common course numbering system approved by the board.
- 15 (b) Each general academic teaching institution shall
- 16 include in the guidelines published on the institution's Internet
- 17 website under Subsection (a) a transfer pathway for each major in
- 18 the top 25 majors at the institution for which students most
- 19 <u>frequently transfer to the institution</u>. A transfer pathway must
- 20 <u>identify:</u>
- 21 (1) the lower division course requirements for the
- 22 major, including the core curriculum requirements; and
- 23 (2) for each public junior college with a service area
- 24 located wholly or partly in a county in which the institution is

- 1 located, each course that may be transferred to the institution
- 2 from the college for course credit applied toward the major or core
- 3 curriculum, listed by the course name and number used by the
- 4 college.
- 5 (c) A general academic teaching institution shall annually
- 6 review and, if necessary, update each transfer pathway required
- 7 <u>under Subsection (b).</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, each general
- 9 academic teaching institution shall develop and publish the
- 10 transfer pathways required under Section 61.830, Education Code, as
- 11 amended by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
