(3) military readiness if the annual graduate:

 (A) achieves a passing score set by the
 applicable military branch on the Armed Services Vocational
 Aptitude Battery; and
 (B) during a time period established by
 commissioner rule, enlists in the armed forces of the United States
 <u>or the Texas National Guard</u>.
