- 4 (ii) the publication, posting, or mailing
- 5 of a notice, statement, or advertisement prohibited by Section

- 7 (2) the sale or rental of the rooms or units in a
- 8 dwelling containing living quarters occupied by or intended to be
- 9 occupied by not more than four families living independently of
- 10 each other, if the owner maintains and occupies one of the living
- 11 quarters as the owner's residence.
- 12 (b) The exemption in Subsection (a)(1) applies only to one
- 13 sale [or rental] in a 24-month period if the owner was not the most
- 14 recent resident of the house at the time of the sale [or rental].
- (c) Subsection (a) does not prohibit the use of attorneys,
- 16 escrow agents, abstractors, title companies, and other
- 17 professional assistants necessary to transfer title.
- 18 (d) For purposes of Subsection (a), a person is in the
- 19 business of selling or renting a dwelling if:
- (1) the person has, within the preceding year,
- 21 participated as the seller or landlord in three or more
- 22 transactions involving the sale or rental of a dwelling or any
- 23 interest in a dwelling;
- 24 (2) the person has, within the preceding year,
- 25 participated in two or more transactions, other than transactions
- 26 involving the person's own dwelling, as an agent providing sales or
- 27 rental facilities or services involving the sale or rental of a

- 2 (3) the person is the owner of a dwelling designed or
- 3 intended for occupancy by, or that is occupied by, five or more
