- 2 relating to a study on the improvement of driver's license issuance
- 3 in this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. STUDY AND REPORT. (a) The Department of Public
- 6 Safety of the State of Texas shall contract with a third party
- 7 entity to conduct a study and create a report on improving the
- 8 process of issuing driver's licenses in this state.
- 9 (b) The study must examine:
- 10 (1) the procedures for issuing driver's licenses in
- 11 other states;
- 12 (2) technological advancements in the issuance of
- 13 driver's licenses, including the development of digital driver's
- 14 licenses;
- 15 (3) the process for issuing driver's licenses in this
- 16 state, including metrics on the amount of time between application
- 17 for a driver's license and receipt of a driver's license; and
- 18 (4) best practices for issuing driver's licenses.
- 19 (c) Not later than May 1, 2022, the Department of Public
- 20 Safety of the State of Texas shall submit to the governor,
- 21 lieutenant governor, and members of the legislature the report
- 22 created under Subsection (a) of this section that includes:
- 23 (1) the findings of the study conducted under this
- 24 section; and

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- 1 (2) any recommendations to improve the process for
- 2 issuing driver's licenses in this state.
- 3 SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires September 1,
- 4 2022.
- 5 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 6 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 7 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 8 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 9 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
