5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 342, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 342.005 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 342.005. FRAUDULENT MEDICAL PRIORITY BOARDING;
9	OFFENSE. (a) An operator of a motor vehicle commits an offense if
10	the operator fraudulently obtains or attempts to obtain priority
11	boarding of a ferry operated by the department that is reserved for
12	vehicles transporting sick or injured persons or medical doctors
13	who are en route for the emergency care of the sick or injured.
14	(b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
