H.B. No. 1188

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring certain open-enrollment charter schools to
3 comply with historically underutilized business provisions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section [12.1058](#), Education Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

7 (d) If an open-enrollment charter school has 5,000 or more
8 students in average daily attendance as determined under Section
9 [48.005](#), the school is considered to be a state agency for purposes
10 of Chapter [2161](#), Government Code.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
