- 2 relating to the period for which certain land owned by a religious
- 3 organization for the purpose of expanding a place of religious
- 4 worship or constructing a new place of religious worship may be
- 5 exempted from ad valorem taxation.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 11.20(j), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (j) A tract of land that is contiguous to the tract of land
- 10 on which the religious organization's place of regular religious
- 11 worship is located may not be exempted under Subsection (a)(6) for
- 12 more than 10 [six] years. A tract of land that is not contiguous to
- 13 the tract of land on which the religious organization's place of
- 14 regular religious worship is located may not be exempted under
- 15 Subsection (a)(6) for more than three years. For purposes of this
- 16 subsection, a tract of land is considered to be contiguous with
- 17 another tract of land if the tracts are divided only by a road,
- 18 railroad track, river, or stream.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to ad valorem taxes imposed
- 20 for a tax year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
