A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to a state employment preference for certain individuals who reside with veterans with a disability. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 657.002, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 657.002. INDIVIDUALS 7 QUALIFIED FOR VETERAN'S EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. The following individuals qualify for a 8 9 veteran's employment preference: (1) a veteran, including a veteran with a disability; 10 11 (2) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not 12 remarried; [and] 13 (3) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed 14 while on active duty; and 15 (4) an individual who resides in a household with a 16 veteran if the individual is the primary source of income for the household and the veteran: 17 18 (A) has a total disability rating based either on having a service-connected disability with a disability rating of 19 100 percent or on individual unemployability; and 20 21 (B) is receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq. or Social 22 23 Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. 24 Section 401 et seq.

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SECTION 2. Section 657.003(b), Government Code, is amended
to read as follows:

3 (b) A state agency shall provide to an individual entitled 4 to a veteran's employment preference for employment or appointment 5 over other applicants for the same position who do not have a 6 greater qualification a veteran's employment preference, in the 7 following order of priority:

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a veteran with a disability;

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(2) a veteran;

10 (3) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not 11 remarried; [and]

12 (4) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed
13 while on active duty; and

14 (5) an individual who resides with a veteran with a
15 disability as described by Section 657.002(4) if the individual is
16 the primary source of income for the veteran's household.

SECTION 3. Section 657.005(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) An applicant who is <u>either</u> a veteran with a disability as described by Section 657.002(4) or an individual who resides with a veteran with a disability as described by Section 657.002(4) if the individual is the primary source of income for the veteran's household shall furnish the official records to the individual whose duty is to fill the position.

25 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 26 an open position with a state agency for which the state agency 27 begins accepting applications on or after the effective date of

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1 this Act. An open position with a state agency for which the state 2 agency begins accepting applications before the effective date of 3 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the state 4 agency began accepting applications, and the former law is 5 continued in effect for that purpose.

6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
