- 13 the most recent certified county property tax rolls; or
- 14 (2) in a district created before September 1, 2017,
- 15 the owners of at least 55 percent of the assessed value of the
- 16 property subject to assessment or taxation by the district based on
- 17 the most recent certified county property tax rolls.
- SECTION 2. Section 68.352(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (b) The board shall dissolve the district on written
- 21 petition filed with the board by the owners of at least two-thirds
- 22 of the assessed value of the property subject to assessment or
- 23 taxation by the district based on the most recent certified county
- 24 property tax rolls [A district may be dissolved as provided by

- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a petition described by Section 375.262, Local Government Code, filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A petition filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the petition was filed, and the former law is
