- 14 Services is named permanent managing conservator of a child whose
- 15 parents' rights have not been terminated, the court shall order

- 18 (b-1) In a proceeding described by Subsection (b) in which
- 19 the court renders an order modifying an existing order for the

- 22 provide notice of the order to the office of the attorney general
- 23 not later than the 10th day after the date the order is rendered.
