 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the membership of the board of managers for certain
 1-20 emergency communication districts.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 772.306(o), Health and Safety Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (o) In a ~~[an emergency communication]~~ district subject to
 1-25 this subchapter located wholly ~~[entirely]~~ in a county with a
 1-26 population of less than 40,000 ~~[30,000]~~, the board consists of:

1-27 (1) the appropriate members listed in Subsection (c);
 1-28 and

1-29 (2) a peace officer licensed under Chapter 1701,
 1-30 Occupations Code, appointed by the county sheriff.

1-31 SECTION 2. The sheriff of a county to which Section
 1-32 772.306(o), Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, applies
 1-33 shall appoint a peace officer to the board of managers as required
 1-34 by Section 772.306(o) as soon as practicable after the effective
 1-35 date of this Act.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
