A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the registration of voters at a polling place and
- 3 related procedures.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 12.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.007. CERTAIN ELECTION OFFICERS ARE VOTER
- 8 REGISTRARS. The registrar shall appoint at least one election
- 9 officer serving each polling place for early voting by personal
- 10 appearance or on election day as a regular deputy registrar.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 12 Section 63.010 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 63.010. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING
- 14 PROCEDURES. (a) Other applicable provisions of this code apply to
- 15 the conduct of voting and to the registration of voters under this
- 16 section to the extent those provisions do not conflict with this
- 17 <u>section.</u>
- 18 (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election
- 19 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered
- 20 voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's
- 21 residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person:
- (1) submits a voter registration application that
- 23 complies with Section 13.002 to a voter registrar at the polling
- 24 place; and

- 1 (2) presents as proof of identification:
- 2 (A) a form of photo identification listed in
- 3 Section 63.0101(a) that states the person's current address on the
- 4 day the person seeks to vote; or
- 5 (B) a document listed in Section 63.0101(b)(2)
- 6 and another form of identification listed in Section 63.0101(a),
- 7 (b)(1), or (b)(3).
- 8 <u>(c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed</u>
- 9 separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under
- 10 regular procedures.
- 11 (d) The secretary of state shall adopt rules to ensure the
- 12 accountability of election officers and to fairly implement this
- 13 section.
- SECTION 3. Section 85.031(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) For each person entitled to vote an early voting ballot
- 17 by personal appearance or entitled to register at a polling place,
- 18 the early voting clerk shall follow the procedure for accepting or
- 19 registering a regular voter on election day, with the modifications
- 20 necessary for the conduct of early voting.
- 21 SECTION 4. The secretary of state shall adopt rules as
- 22 required by Section 63.010, Election Code, as added by this Act, not
- 23 later than February 1, 2022.
- SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 25 an election for which early voting by personal appearance begins on
- 26 or after February 1, 2022.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
