Section 551.304(a), Transportation Code, 4 is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (a) An operator may operate a neighborhood electric vehicle: 7 (1) in a master planned community: 8 9 (A) that is a residential subdivision as defined by Section 209.002(9), Property Code; 10 11 (B) that has in place a uniform set of 12 restrictive covenants; or (C) [and 13 [(B)] for which a county or municipality has 14 approved one or more plats [a plat]; 15 (2) on a public or private beach; or 16 (3) on a public highway for which the posted speed 17 limit is not more than 35 miles per hour, if the neighborhood 18 electric vehicle is operated: 19 (A) during the daytime; and 20 not more than <u>five</u> [two] miles from the 21 (B) 22 location where the neighborhood electric vehicle is usually parked 23 and for transportation to or from a golf course. SECTION 2. Section 551.403, Transportation Code, is amended 24

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
