1 AN ACT 2 relating to the operation of golf carts in certain areas. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 551.403, Transportation Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: Sec. 551.403. OPERATION AUTHORIZED IN CERTAIN AREAS. (a) An 6 7 operator may operate a golf cart: in a master planned community: 8 (1) that is a residential subdivision as defined 9 (A) by Section 209.002(9), Property Code, or has in place a uniform set 10 11 of restrictive covenants; and 12 (B) for which a county or municipality has 13 approved <u>one or more plats</u> [a plat]; 14 (2) on a public or private beach that is open to vehicular traffic; or 15 on a highway for which the posted speed limit is 16 (3) not more than 35 miles per hour, if the golf cart is operated: 17 18 (A) during the daytime; and 19 not more than five [two] miles from the (B) location where the golf cart is usually parked 20 for and 21 transportation to or from a golf course. 22 (b) Notwithstanding Section 551.402(b), a person may operate a golf cart in a master planned community described by 23 Subsection (a) without a golf cart license plate on a highway for 24

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which the posted speed limit is not more than 35 miles per hour, 1 including through an intersection of a highway for which the posted 2 speed limit is more than 35 miles per hour. 3 4 SECTION 2. Section 551.4031, Transportation Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 551.4031. PROHIBITION OF OPERATION ON HIGHWAY ΒY MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY, OR DEPARTMENT. (a) A county or municipality 7 8 may prohibit the operation of a golf cart on a highway under Section 551.403 [551.404] if the governing body of the county or 9 10 municipality determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety. 11 The Texas Department of Transportation may prohibit the 12 (b) operation of a golf cart on a highway under Section 551.403 13 14 [551.404] if the department determines that the prohibition is 15 necessary in the interest of safety.

SECTION 3. Section 551.404(c), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

18 (c) Subsection (b) applies only to a county that:

19 (1) borders or contains a portion of the Red River; or
20 (2) [borders or contains a portion of the Guadalupe
21 River and contains a part of a barrier island that] borders the Gulf
22 of Mexico and has a population of less than 500,000[; or

23 [(3) is adjacent to a county described by Subdivision 24 (2) and: 25 [(A) has a population of less than 37,000; and

26 [(B) contains a part of a barrier island or
27 peninsula that borders the Culf of Mexico].

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1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
