(a) The secretary of state shall develop voter 8 9 education materials for parents on the procedures under Section 64.002(b) that allow a child under 14 years of age to read and mark 10 the ballot while accompanying the child's parent to a voting 11 station. The secretary shall make the voter education materials 12 available on the secretary's Internet website. 13 14 (b) The county officer responsible for administering elections in a county to which Section 31.125 applies shall make the 15 16 voter education materials developed by the secretary of state under Subsection (a) available on the county's Internet website. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 64.002(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 (b) A child under 18 years of age may accompany the child's 20 parent to a voting station, and if the child is under 14 years of 21 age, may read or mark the ballot at the direction of the parent. 22 23 Reading or marking a ballot under this subsection does not constitute assisting a voter for purposes of Subchapter B. 24
