- 2 relating to increasing the criminal penalty for assault or
- aggravated assault of a process server. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.01(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- as follows: 6
- (b) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a Class A 7
- misdemeanor, except that the offense is a felony of the third degree 8
- 9 if the offense is committed against:
- (1) a person the actor knows is a public servant while 10
- the public servant is lawfully discharging an official duty, or in 11
- 12 retaliation or on account of an exercise of official power or
- performance of an official duty as a public servant; 13
- 14 (2) a person whose relationship to or association with
- the defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 15
- 16 71.005, Family Code, if:
- (A) it is shown on the trial of the offense that 17
- 18 the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under
- this chapter, Chapter 19, or Section 20.03, 20.04, 21.11, or 25.11 19
- 20 against a person whose relationship to or association with the
- 21 defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005,
- Family Code; or 22
- (B) the offense is committed by intentionally, 23
- 24 recklessly impeding the normal breathing knowingly, or

- 1 circulation of the blood of the person by applying pressure to the
- 2 person's throat or neck or by blocking the person's nose or mouth;
- 3 (3) a person who contracts with government to perform
- 4 a service in a facility as defined by Section 1.07(a)(14), Penal
- 5 Code, or Section 51.02(13) or (14), Family Code, or an employee of
- 6 that person:
- 7 (A) while the person or employee is engaged in
- 8 performing a service within the scope of the contract, if the actor
- 9 knows the person or employee is authorized by government to provide
- 10 the service; or
- 11 (B) in retaliation for or on account of the
- 12 person's or employee's performance of a service within the scope of
- 13 the contract;
- 14 (4) a person the actor knows is a security officer
- 15 while the officer is performing a duty as a security officer;
- 16 (5) a person the actor knows is emergency services
- 17 personnel while the person is providing emergency services;
- 18 (6) a person the actor knows is a process server while
- 19 the person is performing a duty as a process server;
- 20 (7) a pregnant individual to force the individual to
- 21 have an abortion; or
- 22 (8) [(7)] a person the actor knows is pregnant at the
- 23 time of the offense.
- SECTION 2. Section 22.01(e), Penal Code, is amended by
- 25 adding Subdivision (2) to read as follows:
- 26 (2) "Process server" has the meaning assigned by
- 27 Section 156.001, Government Code.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 22.02(b) and (d), Penal Code, are
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the second
- 4 degree, except that the offense is a felony of the first degree if:
- 5 (1) the actor uses a deadly weapon during the
- 6 commission of the assault and causes serious bodily injury to a
- 7 person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is
- 8 described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005, Family Code;
- 9 (2) regardless of whether the offense is committed
- 10 under Subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2), the offense is committed:
- 11 (A) by a public servant acting under color of the
- 12 servant's office or employment;
- 13 (B) against a person the actor knows is a public
- 14 servant while the public servant is lawfully discharging an
- 15 official duty, or in retaliation or on account of an exercise of
- 16 official power or performance of an official duty as a public
- 17 servant;
- 18 (C) in retaliation against or on account of the
- 19 service of another as a witness, prospective witness, informant, or
- 20 person who has reported the occurrence of a crime; [or]
- 21 (D) against a person the actor knows is a process
- 22 server while the person is performing a duty as a process server; or
- (E) against a person the actor knows is a
- 24 security officer while the officer is performing a duty as a
- 25 security officer; or
- 26 (3) the actor is in a motor vehicle, as defined by
- 27 Section 501.002, Transportation Code, and:

- 1 (A) knowingly discharges a firearm at or in the
- 2 direction of a habitation, building, or vehicle;
- 3 (B) is reckless as to whether the habitation,
- 4 building, or vehicle is occupied; and
- 5 (C) in discharging the firearm, causes serious
- 6 bodily injury to any person.
- 7 (d) In this section:
- 8 <u>(1) "Process server" has the meaning assigned by</u>
- 9 Section 156.001, Government Code.
- 10 <u>(2) "Security</u> [, "security] officer" means a
- 11 commissioned security officer as defined by Section 1702.002,
- 12 Occupations Code, or a noncommissioned security officer registered
- 13 under Section 1702.221, Occupations Code.
- 14 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 19 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 21 committed before that date.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
