Section 22.01(b), Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (b) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a Class A 7 misdemeanor, except that the offense is a felony of the third degree 8 9 if the offense is committed against: (1) a person the actor knows is a public servant while 10 11 the public servant is lawfully discharging an official duty, or in 12 retaliation or on account of an exercise of official power or performance of an official duty as a public servant; 13 14 (2) a person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 15 16 71.005, Family Code, if: (A) it is shown on the trial of the offense that 17 18 the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under this chapter, Chapter 19, or Section 20.03, 20.04, 21.11, or 25.11 19 20 against a person whose relationship to or association with the 21 defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005, Family Code; or 22 (B) the offense is committed by intentionally, 23 24 recklessly impeding the normal breathing knowingly, or or

Sections 22.02(b) and (d), Penal Code, are amended to read as follows: 2 An offense under this section is a felony of the second 3 (b) degree, except that the offense is a felony of the first degree if: 4 5 (1) the actor uses a deadly weapon during the commission of the assault and causes serious bodily injury to a 6 person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is 7 8 described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005, Family Code; 9 (2) regardless of whether the offense is committed under Subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2), the offense is committed: 10 by a public servant acting under color of the 11 (A) servant's office or employment; 12 against a person the actor knows is a public 13 (B) 14 servant while the public servant is lawfully discharging an 15 official duty, or in retaliation or on account of an exercise of official power or performance of an official duty as a public 16 17 servant; (C) in retaliation against or on account of the 18 19 service of another as a witness, prospective witness, informant, or person who has reported the occurrence of a crime; [or] 20 21 against a person the actor knows is a process (D) server while the person is performing a duty as a process server; or 22 (E) 23 against a person the actor knows is а 24 security officer while the officer is performing a duty as a security officer; or 25 (3) the actor is in a motor vehicle, as defined by 26 27 Section 501.002, Transportation Code, and:

1 (A) knowingly discharges a firearm at or in the 2 direction of a habitation, building, or vehicle; 3 (B) is reckless as to whether the habitation, building, or vehicle is occupied; and 4 5 (C) in discharging the firearm, causes serious bodily injury to any person. 6 7 (d) In this section: 8 (1) "Process server" has the meaning assigned by Section 156.001, Government Code. 9 "Security [<del>, "security</del>] officer" 10 (2) means а commissioned security officer as defined by Section 1702.002, 11 12 Occupations Code, or a noncommissioned security officer registered under Section 1702.221, Occupations Code. 13 14 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 16 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,

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18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 19 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 21 committed before that date.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
