- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 161.101, Family Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.101. PETITION ALLEGATIONS; PETITION AND MOTION
- 8 REQUIREMENTS. (a) A petition for the termination of the
- 9 parent-child relationship is sufficient without the necessity of
- 10 specifying the underlying facts if the petition alleges in the
- 11 statutory language the ground for the termination and that
- 12 termination is in the best interest of the child.
- (b) A petition or motion filed by the Department of Family
- 14 and Protective Services in a suit for termination of the
- 15 parent-child relationship is subject to Chapter 10, Civil Practice
- 16 and Remedies Code, and Rule 13, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.
- SECTION 2. Section 161.101, Family Code, as amended by this
- 18 Act, applies only to a petition or motion filed by the Department of
- 19 Family and Protective Services on or after the effective date of
- 20 this Act. A petition or motion filed by the department before that
- 21 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the petition or
- 22 motion was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 23 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
