 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 198 in  
 1-21 Henderson County as the Deputy Sheriff Tony Ogburn and Deputy  
 1-22 Sheriff Paul Habelt Memorial Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.190 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.190. DEPUTY SHERIFF TONY OGBURN AND DEPUTY SHERIFF  
 1-27 PAUL HABELT MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of State Highway 198  
 1-28 in Henderson County between its intersection with the Kaufman  
 1-29 County line and its intersection with State Highway 31 is  
 1-30 designated as the Deputy Sheriff Tony Ogburn and Deputy Sheriff  
 1-31 Paul Habelt Memorial Highway.

1-32 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-33 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
 1-34 designation as the Deputy Sheriff Tony Ogburn and Deputy Sheriff  
 1-35 Paul Habelt Memorial Highway and any other appropriate information;  
 1-36 and

1-37 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
 1-38 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
