6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 1579.010 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 1579.010. PARTICIPATING ENTITY REQUEST FOR CERTAIN
9	INFORMATION. (a) Subject to Subsection (b), the trustee shall
0	provide to a participating entity any de-identified health

- provide to a participating entity any de-identified health information, enrollment information, or other relevant information available to the trustee as requested by the entity in connection with a search for alternative health benefit plan coverage for the entity's employees and the employees' dependents.
- 15 (b) The information provided by the trustee under this
 16 section may not include any personally identifying information of a
 17 covered individual that would be prohibited from disclosure under
 18 the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996
 19 (Pub. L. No. 104-191) and regulations adopted under that Act.
- 20 <u>(c) The trustee shall provide the information requested</u>
 21 <u>under this section at no cost to the requesting participating</u>
 22 <u>entity, in accordance with the procedures developed by the trustee</u>
 23 <u>for that purpose.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
