5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 411.056 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 411.056. REPORTING ON POLICE OFFICER DISCIPLINARY
8	APPEAL HEARINGS. The department shall publish on the department's
9	Internet website the information reported to the department under
10	Section 180.008, Local Government Code.
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
12	by adding Section 180.008 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 180.008. ARBITRATOR REPORTING REGARDING CERTAIN
14	DISCIPLINARY APPEAL HEARINGS FOR POLICE OFFICERS. An arbitrator
15	selected to hear an appeal of the disciplinary suspension or
16	dismissal of a municipal police officer, deputy sheriff, deputy
17	constable, or other police officer, including an appeal under
18	Section 143.057 or 143.1016 or under a collective bargaining, meet
19	and confer, or other similar agreement, shall report to the
20	Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas, for each hearing
21	arbitrated by the arbitrator:
22	(1) the ruling in the hearing;
23	(2) the date of the ruling;
24	(3) sources of the arbitrator's payment; and

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- 1 (4) amounts paid to the police officer as a result of
- 2 the ruling in the hearing.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 180.008, Local Government Code, as added
- 4 by this Act, applies only to a disciplinary appeal that is initiated
- 5 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
