4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 453.301(a-2), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a-2) A physical therapist <u>may treat a patient under</u>
- 8 Subsection (a) for not more than 15 consecutive business days if the
- 9 physical therapist:

- 10 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ [who] possesses a doctoral degree described by
- 11 Subsection (a)(3)(A) $\underline{;}$ and
- 12 <u>(2)</u> either:
- 13 (A) has completed a residency or fellowship; or
- 14 (B) is certified by an entity approved by the
- 15 <u>board</u> [may treat a patient under Subsection (a) for not more than 15
- 16 consecutive business days].
- SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2021, the Texas Board
- 18 of Physical Therapy Examiners shall adopt rules necessary to
- 19 implement Section 453.301(a-2), Occupations Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
