5	SECTION 1. Section 155.207, Family Code, is amended to read

8	the 10th working day after the date an order of transfer is signed,
9	the clerk of the court transferring a proceeding shall send, using
10	the electronic filing system established under Section 72.031,

12	is being made:
13	(1) <u>a transfer certificate and index of transferred</u>
14	documents [the pleadings in the pending proceeding and any other

9 <u>(e) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring</u> 10 <u>courts may each produce under Chapter 51</u>, <u>Government Code</u>, 11 <u>certified or uncertified copies of documents filed in a case</u> 12 <u>transferred under this section, but shall also include a copy of the</u> 13 <u>transfer certificate and index of transferred documents with each</u> 14 <u>document produced</u>.

(f) Sections 80.001 and 80.002, Government Code, do not

SECTION 2. Section 51.3071, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51.3071. TRANSFER OF CASES. (a) If a case is transferred from a district court to a county court, the clerk of the district court <u>shall</u> [may] send to the county clerk <u>using the</u> <u>electronic filing system established under Section 72.031</u> [in <u>electronic or paper form</u>]:

(c) The clerk of the transferee court shall accept documents
 transferred under Subsection (a) and docket the case.

14 (d) The clerk of the transferee court shall physically or 15 electronically mark or stamp the transfer certificate and index of 16 transferred documents to evidence the date and time of acceptance 17 under Subsection (c), but may not physically or electronically mark 18 or stamp any other document transferred under Subsection (a).

Subchapter C, Chapter 72, Government Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 72.037 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 72.037. PROCEDURE FOR TRANSFER OF CASES 7 PROCEEDINGS. (a) The office shall adopt rules prescribing the 8 documents to be transferred between courts when a transfer of a case or proceeding is ordered under Section 155.207, Family Code, or 9 10 Section 51.3071 or 51.403 of this code. (b) Rules adopted under this section must require the 11 12 transfer of the following documents relating to a transferred case 13 or proceeding: 14 (1) a copy of the original papers filed in the 15 transferring court; (2) a copy of each final order; 16 17 (3) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of transferred documents from each previous transfer; and 18 19 (4) a bill of any costs that have accrued in the transferring court. 20 21 (c) The office shall develop and make available a standardized transfer certificate and index of transferred 22 documents form to be used for the transfer of cases and proceedings 23 24 under Section 155.207, Family Code, and Sections 51.3071 and 51.403 of this code. 25 26 (d) In adopting rules and developing forms under this section, the office shall consult with representatives of county 27

1 and district clerks.

2 SECTION 5. As soon as practicable after the effective date 3 of this Act, the Office of Court Administration of the Texas 4 Judicial System shall adopt rules and develop and make available 5 all forms and materials required by Section 72.037, Government 6 Code, as added by this Act.

7 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
