## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the exemption from registration fees of certain
3	vehicles used by nonprofit disaster relief organizations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 502.454(a), (b), and (f),
6	Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The owner of a commercial motor vehicle, trailer, or
8	semitrailer may apply for registration under Section 502.451 and is
9	exempt from the payment of the registration fee that would
10	otherwise be required by this chapter if the vehicle is <u>:</u>
11	<u>(1)</u> owned [ <del>and used exclusively for emergencies</del> ] by a
12	nonprofit disaster relief organization; and
13	(2) used by the organization exclusively for
14	emergencies, training, equipment maintenance, transportation of
15	disaster relief supplies, or other activities related to disaster
16	<u>relief</u> .
17	(b) An application for registration under this section must
18	include:
19	(1) a statement by the owner of the vehicle that the
20	vehicle is used exclusively <u>as</u> [ <del>for</del> ] <u>described by Subsection (a)</u>
21	[ <del>emergencies</del> ] and has not been used for any other purpose;
22	(2) a statement signed by an officer of the nonprofit
23	disaster relief organization that the vehicle has [not] been used
24	exclusively as described by Subsection (a) [for any purpose other

1 than emergencies] and qualifies for registration under this
2 section; and

3 (3) a reasonable description of the vehicle and the4 emergency equipment included in the vehicle.

(f) A vehicle registered under this section that is used
[for any purpose] other than <u>as described by Subsection (a)</u> [<del>an</del>
<del>emergency</del>] may not again be registered under this section.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
