- 6 amended by adding Section 1702.3876 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1702.3876. IMPERSONATING PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR;
- 8 OFFENSE. (a) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 9 <u>(1) impersonates a private investigator with the</u>
- 10 <u>intent to induce another to submit to the person's pretended</u>
- 11 authority or to rely on the person's pretended acts of a private
- 12 investigator; or
- (2) knowingly purports to exercise any function that
- 14 requires licensure as a private investigator.
- 15 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,
- 16 except that the offense is a felony of the third degree if it is
- 17 shown on the trial of the offense that the defendant has previously
- 18 been convicted of an offense under this section.
