- 2 relating to the carrying of a handgun by a license holder in a motor
- 3 vehicle.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.035(a), Penal Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A license holder commits an offense if the license
- 8 holder carries a handgun on or about the license holder's person
- 9 under the authority of Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code,
- 10 and intentionally displays the handgun in plain view of another
- 11 person in a public place. It is an exception to the application of
- 12 this subsection that the handgun was partially or wholly visible
- 13 but was<u>:</u>
- 14 <u>(1)</u> carried in a shoulder or belt holster by the
- 15 license holder; or
- 16 (2) in a holster, and the handgun and the license
- 17 holder were in a motor vehicle.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to an offense committed on or after January 1, 2022. An offense
- 20 committed before January 1, 2022, is governed by the law in effect
- 21 on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 22 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 23 an offense was committed before January 1, 2022, if any element of
- 24 the offense occurred before that date.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
