1 AN ACT 2 relating to the carrying of a handgun by a license holder in a motor 3 vehicle. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.035(a), Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) A license holder commits an offense if the license 7 holder carries a handgun on or about the license holder's person 8 under the authority of Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, 9 and intentionally displays the handgun in plain view of another 10 person in a public place. It is an exception to the application of 11 12 this subsection that the handgun was partially or wholly visible 13 but was: 14 (1) carried in a shoulder or belt holster by the 15 license holder; or 16 (2) in a holster, and the handgun and the license holder were in a motor vehicle. 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 18 to an offense committed on or after January 1, 2022. An offense 19 committed before January 1, 2022, is governed by the law in effect 20 21 on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, 22 an offense was committed before January 1, 2022, if any element of 23 the offense occurred before that date. 24
