## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to business days for purposes of the public information
3	law.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.0031 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.0031. BUSINESS DAYS. (a) Except as provided by
8	this section, in this chapter "business day" means a day other than
9	<u>a:</u>
10	(1) Saturday or Sunday;
11	(2) national holiday under Section 662.003(a); or
12	(3) state holiday under Section 662.003(b).
13	(b) An optional holiday under Section 662.003(c) is not a
14	business day of a governmental body if the officer for public
15	information of the governmental body observes the optional holiday.
16	(c) A holiday established by the governing body of an
17	institution of higher education under Section 662.011(a) is not a
18	business day of the institution of higher education.
19	(d) The Friday before or Monday after a holiday described by
20	Subsection (a)(2) or (3) is not a business day of a governmental
21	body if the holiday occurs on a Saturday or Sunday and the
22	governmental body observes the holiday on that Friday or Monday.
23	(e) Subject to the requirements of this subsection, a
24	governmental body may designate a day on which the governmental

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1 body's administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum staffing as a non-business day. The designation of a non-business 2 day for an independent school district must be made by the board of 3 trustees. The designation of a non-business day for a governmental 4 5 body other than an independent school district must be made by the executive director or other chief administrative officer. A 6 7 governmental body may designate not more than 10 non-business days under this subsection each calendar year. A governmental body 8 shall make a good faith effort to post advance notice of the 9 non-business days designated under this subsection on 10 the governmental body's Internet website. 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 12

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13 to a request for public information received by a governmental body 14 or officer for public information on or after the effective date of 15 this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
