5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 2252, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 2252.909 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 2252.909. LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR NEGOTIATED RATES
9	UNDER CERTAIN HEALTH BENEFIT CONTRACTS. (a) In this
10	section, "health care vendor" means:
11	(1) a health benefit plan issuer that contracts with
12	this state for the administration of health benefits; and
13	(2) a managed care organization that contracts with
14	the Health and Human Services Commission to administer health
15	benefits for Medicaid recipients through a managed care plan.
16	(b) This section applies only to a health care vendor that
17	contracts with this state, including with an agency of this state,
18	to administer health benefits under:
19	(1) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551,
20	<pre>Insurance Code;</pre>
21	(2) a basic plan under Chapter 1575, Insurance Code;
22	(3) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579,
23	<pre>Insurance Code;</pre>
24	(4) a plan providing basic coverage under Chapter

- 1 1601, Insurance Code; or
- 2 (5) the state Medicaid program, including the Medicaid
- 3 managed care program operated under Chapter 533.
- 4 (c) A member of the legislature may request from a health
- 5 care vendor information regarding any negotiated rate included in a
- 6 contract between the vendor and this state for the administration
- 7 of health benefits.
- 8 <u>(d) On receipt of a written request for information under</u>
- 9 Subsection (c), the health care vendor shall provide the requested
- 10 information to the member of the legislature who submitted the
- 11 request.
- 12 (e) A health care vendor, by providing information under
- 13 this section that is confidential or otherwise excepted from
- 14 required disclosure under law, does not waive or affect the
- 15 confidentiality of the information for purposes of state or federal
- 16 law or waive the right to assert exceptions to required disclosure
- 17 of the information in the future.
- (f) A member of the legislature or legislative staff who
- 19 receives information from a health care vendor under this section
- 20 may not disclose that information to any person who does not have a
- 21 right to access that information under this section.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 2252.909, Government Code, as added by
- 23 this Act, applies only to a health care vendor that enters into or
- 24 renews a contract with the State of Texas on or after the effective
- 25 date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
