4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter KK, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2306.9055 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.9055. STATEWIDE PARTICIPATION IN HOMELESS
8	MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM. (a) The council shall evaluate,
9	encourage, incentivize, and monitor the participation by service
10	providers to the homeless throughout this state in a regional or
11	statewide homeless management information system to:
12	(1) achieve statewide participation in a homeless
13	management information system by service providers to the homeless;
14	(2) improve the collaboration and coordination of
15	services to the homeless;
16	(3) increase transparency and accountability in the
17	provision of services to the homeless; and
18	(4) prevent the loss of state and federal funding for
19	services to the homeless.
20	(b) The council shall prepare and submit quarterly reports
21	to the department on:
22	(1) the rate of participation by service providers to
23	the homeless in a homeless management information system,
24	aggregated by region and participation trends throughout this

2	(2) barriers to achieving statewide participation in a
3	homeless management information system, including data input
4	issues and quality control challenges related to statewide
5	participation in a homeless management information system, and
6	potential solutions to those barriers;
7	(3) available funding sources to provide resources and
8	incentivize participation in a homeless management information
9	system;
10	(4) an estimated timeline for updates to and the
11	continued customization of homeless management information systems
12	used by service providers to the homeless throughout this state;
13	(5) the compliance with procurement regulations and
14	privacy laws by homeless management information systems used by
15	service providers to the homeless throughout this state;
16	(6) feedback from participating and nonparticipating
17	service providers to the homeless on:
18	(A) the ease of access to participate in a
19	homeless management information system; and
20	(B) the local oversight of homeless management
21	information system administrators;
22	(7) recommendations provided by homeless management
23	information system administrators throughout this state on
24	carrying out this section and achieving statewide participation in
25	a homeless management information system; and
26	(8) data-driven scenarios that have improved the
27	provision of services to the homeless throughout this state.

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(c) In carrying out this section and to achieve the goal of
statewide participation in a homeless management information
system, the council may seek assistance from the Texas Homeless
Network or any other organization in this state with a network of
service providers to the homeless.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
