- 7 SHERIFF. (a) A person is not eligible to serve as sheriff unless

- 9 (1) has a high school diploma or a high school
- 10 equivalency certificate; and
- 11 (2) holds an active permanent peace officer
- 12 license [is eligible to be licensed] under Chapter 1701 [Sections
- 14 (b) A person is not eligible to be a candidate for the office
- 15 of sheriff unless the person holds an active permanent peace
- officer license under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 1701.302(a), Occupations Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) Except as provided by Section 85.0011, Local Government
- 20 Code, an [An] officer[, including a sheriff,] elected under the
- 21 Texas Constitution or a statute or appointed to fill a vacancy in an
- 22 elective office must obtain a license from the commission not later

- 2 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 3 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, do not apply to a
- 4 sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date of this
- 5 Act. A sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date
- 6 of this Act is governed for the remainder of that term by Sections
- 7 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, as those laws existed
- 8 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the prior law
- 9 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
