Section 1701.302(a), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 18 (a) Except as provided by Section 85.0011, Local Government 19 Code, an [An] officer[, including a sheriff,] elected under the 20 21 Texas Constitution or a statute or appointed to fill a vacancy in an elective office must obtain a license from the commission not later 22 than the second anniversary of the date the officer takes office. 23

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 2 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, do not apply to a 3 4 sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date of this Act. A sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date 5 6 of this Act is governed for the remainder of that term by Sections 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, as those laws existed 7 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the prior law 8 is continued in effect for that purpose. 9

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
