- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 31.032(d), Human Resources Code, is 6
- amended to read as follows: 7
- (d) In determining whether an applicant is eligible for 8
- assistance, the commission shall exclude from the applicant's 9
- available resources: 10

- \$5,000 [\$1,000] for the applicant's household, 11
- including a household in which there is a person with a disability 12
- or a person who is at least 60 years of age; and 13
- 14 (2) each [the fair market value of the applicant's
- ownership interest in a] motor vehicle in which the applicant or a 15
- member of the applicant's household has an ownership interest[, but 16
- not more than \$5,000 plus or minus an amount to be determined 17
- annually beginning on October 1, 1997, to reflect changes in the new 18
- car component of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers 19
- published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics]. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
- 22 is amended by adding Section 33.021 to read as follows:
- 23 Sec. 33.021. EXCLUSION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN DETERMINING
- 24 SNAP ELIGIBILITY. In determining the eligibility of an applicant

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- 1 for or recertifying the eligibility of a recipient of supplemental
- 2 nutrition assistance program benefits, the commission shall
- 3 <u>exclude from the applicant's available resources each motor vehicle</u>
- 4 in which the applicant or recipient or a member of the applicant's
- 5 or recipient's household has an ownership interest.
- 6 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to:
- 7 (1) an initial determination or redetermination of
- 8 eligibility of a person for financial assistance under Chapter 31,
- 9 Human Resources Code, that is made on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act; and
- 11 (2) an initial determination or recertification of
- 12 eligibility of a person for the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 13 program under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, that is made on or
- 14 after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 16 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 17 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 18 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 19 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 20 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
