- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 86, Natural Resources
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 86.186 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 86.186. ELIMINATION OF ROUTINE FLARING. (a) The
- 9 commission by rule shall establish a policy to eliminate before
- 10 December 31, 2025, the routine flaring of gas from wells or other
- 11 facilities regulated by the commission.
- 12 (b) The policy may include:
- 13 (1) regulatory, incentive-based, or voluntary
- 14 approaches for achieving the goals of the policy; and
- 15 (2) interim goals for individual wells or other
- 16 facilities or for operators of wel<u>ls or other facilities.</u>
- 17 <u>(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the policy must</u>
- 18 <u>allow flaring for safety or emergency purposes or purposes</u>
- 19 authorized under Section 86.185.
- 20 (d) The policy may not allow flaring to be conducted for an
- 21 extended period for a purpose that is not related to safety or an
- 22 emergency.

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23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
