9	impact statement for each bill or resolution that creates a new

11	offense.
12	(b) The impact statement must include information
13	concerning the impact of the legislation on racial and ethnic
14	minority groups, including a statistical analysis of the impact on
15	those groups with regard to sentencing of defendants and the
16	eligibility of defendants for release on parole.
17	(c) The board shall consult with the Department of Public
18	Safety and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice to develop a
19	protocol for analyzing the impact of the bill or resolution on
20	racial and ethnic minority groups.
21	(d) The impact statement must be attached to the bill or
22	resolution immediately following:
23	(1) the fiscal note attached under Section 314.003; or
