Section 209.014(a), Property Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) Notwithstanding any provision in a dedicatory instrument, a board of a property owners' association shall call an 8 9 annual meeting of the members of the association. An annual meeting may be held by any method of communication, including electronic or 10 telephonic means as described by Section 6.002, Business 11 Organizations Code, provided that: 12 (1) each person in attendance at the meeting may hear 13 14 and be heard by every other person at the meeting; and (2) the notice of the meeting sent to members of the 15 association includes instructions to access any communication 16 method required to attend the meeting remotely. 17 SECTION 2. Section 209.00592(a-1), Property Code, 18 is amended to read as follows: 19 (a-1) Except as provided by this subsection, [unless 20 21 dedicatory instrument provides otherwise, ] a property owners' 22 association is not required to provide an owner with more than one

23 voting method. An owner must be allowed to vote by <u>one of the</u> 24 following voting methods:

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
